

Free Non-Juried Exhibition Opportunity Antfarm ArtMart

First Friday in May 2008

Art Mart to open at Antfarm Studios in Boylan Heights during May First Friday in Raleigh. If you are a 2D artist and want to show your work during the first Friday in May, here's your chance. Antfarm is reserving some gallery space just for you. Work does not have to be framed, wired or necessarily "finished", should be no larger than 8" x 10" and priced no higher than \$50. Working on something in your sketchbook? Rip it out, bring it and hang it....and maybe sell it. Here's how it works.

1. Make art.
2. Put art in protective cover (or not) with a price (\$50 or less), your name and contact info on the cover and also the back of the work.
3. Come to Antfarm at 303 Kinsey Street between 5:45 and 6:00 p.m. on First Friday to hang your work...plan on using a pushpin or tape.
4. Sign in and complete a waiver form.
 - a. Hang around and see what people have to say.
 - b. Eat, drink and be merry.
5. Give a self-addressed, stamped envelope to Maria Falbo or Ellen Divers before you leave Antfarm if you'd like:
 - a. money mailed to you if your work sells; and/or
 - b. your work mailed back to you. (note that work should fit into the envelope, so pick a size that suits your work unless you don't mind it being folded)
6. All work will be taken down and mailed the week after First Friday.
7. As a courtesy, please email Maria falbom@bluezootstudio.com with your name and contact info to let us know you plan on participating.

The gallery will also display Antfarmer(s)' NEW work in progress and is open to the public for First Friday.
